



How to Qualify for Year End Awards in 2019

The 2019 Series will contain two day race formats consisting of 14 races at 7 tracks.

Main gates will open @ 6:00 pm the night prior along with pre-tech and registration.

{The Gateway –Grattan--Mid Ohio – Heartland Park & NCM Events are 3 Day formats that Include a Friday Practice }

Each CES Event weekend will consist of two point's races.

Each Event Date is a separate Entry Fee and separate Points race.

All Race Points will be combined as each day is a separate race.

One series champion will be crowned per class.

Your best 10 race finishes of the 14 races will count towards year end points.

The 4-cycle classes that run twice each Day Your best 20 race finishes of the 28 races will count towards year end points.

You must compete in a Minimum of 9 Race days & be a member of TAG Racing Int. / CES to qualify for series year end awards.

For the 2019 season you must be a member of CES / TAG to participate in the Championship Enduro Series events. You can purchase an annual membership or you can purchase your membership on a per-event basis which ever you choose. If you choose to purchase your membership on a per event basis after 5 weekend events you membership will become paid for the 2019 season and you will qualify for year end awards.
